MREŽE I ČLANSTVA / NETWORKS AND MEMBERSHIPS

Tokom 2017. godine DZPPS je učestvovalo u radu sledećih mreža organizacija civilnog društva: BirdLife International, Koalicije 27, SEENET i BioNET mreže. /

In 2017, BPSSS was engaged in the activities of the following CSO networks: BirdLife International, Coalition 27, SEENET and BioNET.

BirdLife International



BirdLife International je globalno partnerstvo organizacija koje teže očuvanju ptica, njihovih staništa i globalne biološke raznolikosti. BirdLife International je široko priznat kao svetski lider u zaštiti ptica. Nauka i praktične aktivnosti na terenu na važnim područjima i staništima, omogućavaju sprovođenje uspešnih programa očuvanja ptica i njihovih staništa. Mreža okuplja preko 120 BirdLife partnera širom sveta. Članovi mreže su po jedan predstavnik iz zemalja Evrope, Azije i Afrike, čime je Društvo ukazano izuzetno poverenje. Značajna potvrda našeg rada došla je 2013. kada je Društvo zvanično postalo pridruženi član i predstavnik za Srbiju globalne mreže BirdLife International. Veoma bitna godina za Društvo je 2018. kada postaje punopravan član i deo porodice BirdLife International.

BirdLife International is a global partnership of conservation organisations (NGOs) that strives to conserve birds, their habitats and global biodiversity. BirdLife is widely recognised as the world leader in bird conservation. Science together with practical activities on the ground in important sites and habitats enable the implementation of successful conservation programmes for birds and their habitats. The network brings together over 120 BirdLife partners worldwide. The members of the network are one representative per country of Europe, Asia and Africa, which means that the BPSSS is extremely trusted. Significant confirmation of our work came in 2013, when the BPSSS officially became an associate member and representative of Serbia in this global BirdLife International network. A very important year for the Society is 2018, when BPSSS becomes a full member and part of the BirdLife International family.

Koalicija 27 / Coalition 27



Koalicija je osnovana 2014. godine, prvenstveno radi monitoringa i doprinosa pregovorima u poglavljju 27. Danas, Koalicija 27 okuplja organizacije civilnog društva koje zajedno nastupaju, zagovaraju i podstiču učešće javnosti u procesu pristupnih pregovora Republike Srbije sa Evropskom unijom u oblasti zaštite životne sredine i klimatskih promena.

Najvažniji rezultat rada Koalicije 27 u 2017. godini bio je objavljivanje periodičnog izveštaja „iz senke“ pod nazivom: „Poglavlje 27 u Srbiji: još uvek u pripremi“, o napretku Srbije u procesu pridruživanja Evropskoj uniji u oblastima obuhvaćenim Poglavljem 27 – Životna sredina i klimatske promene. Izveštaj predstavlja nezavisni kritički osvrt na brojne izazove i daje konkretnе predloge Vladi Republike Srbije kako da proces pregovora i pridruživanja Evropskoj uniji rezultira pravim pomakom i poboljšanjem realnog stanja u životnoj sredini. DZPPS je vodilo proces izrade izveštaja za oblast Zaštita prirode. Izveštaj je promovisan u nekoliko gradova Srbije, a delegacija Evropske unije u Srbiji je prepoznala Koaliciju kao važnog činioca u procesu evrointegracije kada je u pitanju civilni sektor.

The Coalition was formed in 2014, primarily to monitor and contribute to the negotiations in Chapter 27. Today, Coalition 27 brings together civil society organizations to jointly advocate and encourage public participation in the Serbia's EU accession negotiations in the field of environmental protection and climate change.

The most important result of Coalition 27's work in 2017 was the publication of a periodic "out of the shadow" report entitled "Chapter 27 in Serbia: still under preparation", on Serbia's progress in the accession process in the areas covered by Chapter 27 - Environment and climate change. The report presents an independent critical review of a number of challenges and provides concrete suggestions to the government of the Republic of Serbia that the process of negotiation and accession to the European Union results in a real shift and an improvement in the real state of the environment. BPSSS led the preparation of the report for the field of nature conservation. The report has been promoted in several cities in Serbia, and the EU delegation in Serbia recognized the Coalition as an important factor in the European integration process in the civilian sector.

SEENET mreža / South East Europe Network for Energy and Transport (SEENET)



SEENET mreža okuplja organizacije koje se bave zaštitom prirode i životne sredine u jugoistočnoj Evropi u cilju uspostavljanja održivog korišćenja energije i transporta u ovom delu Evrope. Misija mreže je da obezbedi platformu za saradnju na regionalnom nivou i da se obezbedi aktivno učešće ekoloških NVO u regionu i međunarodnim procesima bitnim za sektor energetike i saobraćaja, prevenstveno kroz proces javnog zagovaranja.

Od 9. do 13. jula u Hrvatskoj je održana konferencija SEENET mreže koja je bila posvećena problematici negativnog uticaja izgradnje mini hidroelektrana na prirodu i prezentovanju kampanja koje su članice mreže sprovele kako bi sprecile njihovu izgradnju. Jedan od zaključaka konferencije je da je neophodno veće učešće javnosti u samom procesu planiranja izgradnje mini hidroelektrana. U okviru konferencije rad DZPPS-a je predstavljen kroz dve teme: borba protiv kribovolova i revitalizacija bare Rogozare.

SEENET is a network of environmental NGOs for sustainable energy and transport in South East Europe. The mission of the network is to provide a platform for co-operation on the regional level and to ensure the active participation of environmental NGOs in regional and international processes relevant to the energy and transport sectors, primarily through the advocacy process.

From 9 to 13 July, a SEENET network conference was held in Croatia, dedicated to the problem of the negative impact of the construction of mini hydropower plants on nature and the presentation of campaigns undertaken by network members to prevent their construction. One of the conclusions of the conference is that greater public participation is required in the planning process of the construction of mini hydropower plants. Within the conference, the work of the BPSSS was presented through two topics: the fight against poaching and the revitalization of the Rogozara Bar.

BioNET mreža / The Network of Biodiversity Related Civil Society Organizations in South-East Europe



U cilju boljeg povezivanja organizacija na području jugoistočne Europe koje se bave očuvanjem biodiverziteta pokrenuta je neformalna mreža BioNET. Inicijativa je pokrenuta u okviru projekta vođenog od strane Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH. Cilj mreže jeste stvaranje okruženja za poboljšanje očuvanja prirode i promocija održivog razvoja u skladu sa nacionalnim strategijama, regionalnim prioritetima, EU Direktive o pticama i staništima i drugim relevantnim dokumentima.

DZPPS je učestvovalo u organizaciji dva sastanka predstavnika ove mreže tokom 2017. godine. Prvi je održan u Kladovu za predstavnike mreže iz Srbije i inostranstva, sa temom problema u sprovođenju mera zaštite u zaštićenim područjima i načinima za unapređenje ove oblasti kroz razvoj ekoturizma i edukaciju dece i mladih. U decembru, u Beogradu organizovan je drugi sastanak u saradnji sa Mladim istraživačima Srbije, a cilj sastanka je bio razmena informacija o uspostavljanju mreže Natura2000 u Srbiji, o aktivnostima na zaštiti biodiverziteta kao i diskusija o mogućim zajedničkim aktivnostima OCD.

An informal network – BioNET, has been launched for better connection of biodiversity-related organizations in Southeast Europe. The initiative was launched as part of a project led by Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH. The aim of the network is to create an environment for improving nature conservation and promoting sustainable development in accordance with national strategies, regional priorities, the EU Birds and Habitats Directive and other relevant documents.

BPSSS participated in the organization of two meetings of representatives of this network during 2017. The first was held in Kladovo for representatives of the network from Serbia and abroad, with the topic of problems in the implementation of protection measures in protected areas and ways to improve this field through the development of ecotourism and education of children and young people. The second meeting was organized in cooperation with the Young Researchers of Serbia in Belgrade in December, and the aim of the meeting was to exchange information on the establishment of the Natura2000 network in Serbia, activities on biodiversity protection, as well as discussions on possible joint CSO activities.

Protecting biodiversity in the Balkans - Strengthening cooperation along the Balkan Green Belt

CILJ

Cilj Zelenog pojasa jeste povezivanje nekada odvojenih prirodnih celina u jedinstvene ekološke koridore čime bi bila omogućena njihova bolja zaštita. Stručnjaci i zaštitari prirode ujedinjeni oko ideje Zelenog pojasa doprinose ovom cilju prenosom znanja i primenom pozitivnih primera zaštite prirode.

AKTIVNOSTI

- foto-konkurs „Balkanski zeleni pojasi“
 - pristiglo 122 fotografije od 46 fotografa;
- organizovano takmičenje u crtanju za decu u saradnji sa Inicijativom za ruralni razvoj - Centar Jaša Tomić
 - učestvovalo ukupno 56 dece iz 7 gradova;
- Dan zelenog pojasa
 - manifestacija organizovana 24. septembra u Kladovu
 - održana je biciklistička turneja od Kladova do IBA područja Mala Vrbica, koju je podržao Biciklistički klub „Đerdap“
 - otvorena izložba fotografija Green Belt, na kojoj su prikazane fotografije koje predstavljaju prirodne lepote Balkanskog zelenog pojasa
 - pripremljen kulturno-umetnički program i radionice za decu.

THE GOAL

The aim of the Green Belt is to connect once separate natural entities into unique ecological corridors, which would enable them to be better protected. The experts and conservationists united around the Green Belt idea contribute to this goal by transferring knowledge and applying positive examples of nature protection.

ACTIVITIES

- Photo contest „Balkan Green Belt“
 - 122 photos from 46 photographers were received;
- Organized drawing competition for children in cooperation with the Rural Development Initiative - Centar Jaša Tomić
 - 56 children from 7 cities participated;
- Green Belt Day
 - an event organized on 24 September in Kladovo
 - a cycling tour was held from Kladovo to the IBA area of Mala Vrbica, supported by the „Đerdap“ Cycling Club
 - Green Belt photo exhibition opens, featuring photographs representing the natural beauty of the Balkan Green Belt
 - cultural arts program and workshops for children prepared.

THE GOAL

Development of a publication that will provide detailed information on the size of populations of endangered bird species, threat statuses, threat factors and protection measures to be implemented.

- Collection and processing of published and field data;
- Book chapters writing, collecting of photographs, producing of maps.

Formiranje funkcionalnog sistema odmorišta i zimovališta duž Jadranskog selidbenog puta /

Forming of a functional resting area and wintering grounds along the Adriatic migration route – Adriatic Flyway 3

Godina realizacije / Year of realization: 2015–2018.

Koordinator / Coordinator: Milan Ružić

Finansije / Finances: 10.956.000 RSD / 91,300 EUR

CILJ

Formiranje mreže područja u kojima će biti zabranjen lov, a koja su izrazito značajna za odmor, zimovanje i gnezđenje migratoričnih vrsta ptica duž Jadranskog selidbenog puta. Kao i jačanje kapaciteta nacionalnih NVO koje se bave zaštitom ptica i podsticanje saradnje organizacija u državama Jadranskog selidbenog puta.

AKTIVNOSTI

- prikupljanje podataka o migratoričnim vrstama ptica;
- sprečavanje krivolova kroz edukaciju interesnih grupa i jačanje saradnje sa nadležnim organima;
- 70 terenskih izlazaka na Labudovo okno – praćena je jesenja seoba ptica, beležena brojnost ptica i svaka ljudska aktivnost na samom području.

THE GOAL

Establishment of a network of non-hunting areas that are extremely important for resting, wintering and nesting of migratory bird species along the Adriatic migration route. As well as strengthening the capacity of national bird protection NGOs and encouraging the cooperation of organizations in the countries of the Adriatic migration route.

ACTIVITIES

- Collection of data on migratory bird species;
- Prevention of poaching through education of interest groups and strengthening of cooperation with competent authorities;
- 70 field trips to the Labudovo okno – the autumn bird migration was monitored, the number of birds was recorded and all human activity in the area.

Zaštita modrovrane (*Coracias garrulus*) u Karpatskom basenu – istraživanje u Srbiji / Protection of European Roller (*Coracias garrulus*) in the Carpathian Basin - research in Serbia

CILJ

Praćenje uspeha gnežđenja populacija modrovrane u Vojvodini i postavljanje kućica za gnežđenje u cilju oporavka populacije u ovom delu areala.

AKTIVNOSTI

- okupljanje većeg broja jedinki uočeno je na više mesta: Subotička peščara, okolina Novog Bečeja, Novog Miloševa i Kapetanskog rita;
- nastavak monitoringa kućica i markiranja mladunaca;
- zabeleženo je gnežđenje više od 200 parova;
- prstenovima obeleženo više od 450 jedinki.

Širenje areala modrovrane se nastavilo, kolonizovana su nova područja na teritoriji srednje i južne Bačke.

THE GOAL

Monitoring the success of nesting populations of European Roller populations in Vojvodina and setting up nestboxes for the purpose of recovering populations in this part of the area.

ACTIVITIES

- Gathering of more individuals was noticed in several places: Subotička Peščara, the vicinity of Novi Bečeј, Novo Miloševо and Kapetanski rit;
- Continued monitoring of nestboxes and marking of juveniles;
- Nesting of more than 200 pairs has been recorded;
- More than 450 individuals ringed.

The expansion of the European Roller distribution was continued and new areas were colonized in the territory of central and southern Backa.

Izrada dokumenta sa smernicama za upravljanje IBA područjem Labudovo okno, a radi unapređenja zaštite ovog izuzetno važnog odmorišta i hranilišta migratornih vrsta ptica.

AKTIVNOSTI

- organizovano 6 ekspertske radionice:
 - zaštita prirode
 - hidrologija i vodni menadžment
 - ribarstvo i zaštita ribljeg fonda
 - lovstvo i gazdovanje divljači
 - navigacija i rečni transport
 - turizam i ekoturizam;
- organizovane dodatne 3 združene radionice na kojima su izneti krajnji zaključci i preporuke za unapređenje stanja specifičnih oblasti sa ciljem unapređenja zaštite prirode Labudovog okna, sa temama
 - ribarstvo i lovstvo Labudovog okna
 - zaštita prirode i ekoturizam Labudovog okna
 - hidrologija i rečni transport Labudovog okna;
- na radionicama učestvovali predstavnici 26 institucija i organizacija;
- izrađena Studija o prirodnim vrednostima, stanju i smernicama za upravljanje međunarodno značajnim područjem za ptice „Labudovo okno“.

THE GOAL

Creation of a document for the management of the IBA area of the Labudovo okno to improve the protection of this extremely important resting and feeding area for migratory bird species.

ACTIVITIES

- Six expert workshops organized:
 - nature conservation
 - hydrology and water management
 - fisheries and fish protection
 - hunting and game management
 - navigation and river transport
 - tourism and ecotourism
- Additional 3 joint workshops were organized to present the final conclusions and recommendations for improving the condition of specific areas with the aim of improving the nature protection of the Labudovo okno, with topics
 - fisheries and hunting of the Labudovo okno
 - nature conservation and ecotourism of the Labudovo okno
 - hydrology and river transport of the Labudovo okno;
- Representatives of 26 institutions and organizations participated in the workshops;
- A Study on the natural values, status and guidelines for the management of an Internationally Important Bird Area "Labudovo okno".

CILJ

Utvrđivanje najosnovnijih informacija o pticama gnezdaricama – gde žive i koliko ih ima.

AKTIVNOSTI

- završetak svih terenskih aktivnosti za potrebe EBBA2;
- obrada svih do sada prikupljenih podataka (2013-2017);
- održana radionica 17-18. novembra u Sremskim Karlovcima (koordinatori UTM kvadrata u Srbiji izvršili deo procena na radionici, na osnovu prikupljenih i obradjenih podataka od strane administratora baze podataka);
- izrada finalnog nacionalnog izveštaja za EBBA2 50x50 km kvadrate (procene za gnezdarice za svaki od kvadrata koji će biti prikazani u Atlasu).

do kraja 2017. godine uspešno je po-kriveno 184 zadata transepta, odnosno >97% od ukupno definisanih na početku projekta

THE GOAL

Determining the most basic information about breeding birds –where they live and how many are there.

ACTIVITIES

- Completion of all field activities for EBBA2 purposes;*
- Processing of all data collected so far (2013-2017);*
- Workshop was held on 17-18 November in Sremski Karlovci (coordinators of UTM squares in Serbia made part of the assessments at the workshop, based on the data collected and processed by the database administrator);*
- Preparation of the final national report for the EBBA2 50x50 km squares (estimates for breeding birds for each of the squares to be displayed in the Atlas).*

By the end of 2017, 184 assigned transects were successfully covered, more than 97% of the total defined at the beginning of the project

Prikupljanjem i obradom podataka na teritoriji naše zemlje rukovodi tim ornitologa iz Društva za zaštitu i proučavanje ptica Srbije. Vremenski period sakupljanja podataka je 5 godina (2013–2017), dok će do kraja 2020. godine rezultati biti objavljeni u vidu Atlasa – monografije. Društvo se intenzivno uključilo u rad na ovom projektu 2015. godine. Jedan od EBBA2 zadatka je obilazak ukupno 188 unapred definisanih transekata u 55 UTM kvadrata 50x50 km koji se delom ili u celom površinom nalaze u Srbiji.

Data collection and processing on the territory of our country is managed by a team of ornithologists from the Bird Protection and Study Society of Serbia. THE GOAL

The project was implemented as a continuation of many years of research in Tara National Park with the aim of continuous monitoring of bird fauna in the territory of this protected area. The main objective of this program was to collect data on breeding birds, their diversity, and density per unit area.

 - special attention is paid to the bird species that are of high priority for the future integration of the Tara NP into the Natura2000 network: Ural Owl (*Strix uralensis*), Eurasian Pygmy-owl (*Glaucidium passerinum*), White-backed Woodpecker (*Dendrocopos leucotos*), and Three-toed Woodpecker (*Picoides tridactylus*)
 - 576 territories of 33 species were recorded using the line transect method. The most common species were the European Robin (*Erythacus rubecula*) and Common Chaffinch (*Fringilla coelebs*);
- Organized two bird ringing camps during the autumn bird migration
 - 692 individuals were marked within 42 species;
- A training program for young birdringers, was supported by the German Agency for International Cooperation (GIZ).

Evropski vikend posmatranja ptica / European Birdwatching Weekend (EuroBirdwatch)

CILJ

Osnovni cilj je podizanje nivoa svesti građanstva o važnosti i potrebi zaštite ptica selica, kao i očuvanja područja gde se razmnožavaju, odmaraju tokom migracija i područja koja koriste kao zimovališta.

Svake godine tokom prvog vikenda oktobra DZPPS organizuje izlete širom Srbije. Ovom prilikom okuplja se veliki broj posetilaca koji zajedno sa vodičem posmatraju ptice i imaju priliku da saznaju nešto više o čudesnoj seobi ptica, kao i sa kakvim se problemima ptice selice susreću.

AKTIVNOSTI

- 24. Evropski vikend posmatranja ptica organizovan je 30. septembra i 1. oktobra 2017. godine
 - 690 učesnika
 - 20 izleta
 - posmatrano oko 100.000 jedinki ptica, a zabeleženo 139 vrsta
 - najčešće beležene vrste: čvorak, obični galeb i liska.

THE GOAL

The main goal was to raise awareness of the need to save migratory birds, their breeding areas, the stopovers on the migration routes and the wintering places.

Every year during the first weekend of October, BPSSS organizes trips throughout Serbia. On this occasion, a large number of visitors gather together with the guide to watch the birds and have the opportunity to learn more about the wonderful bird migration, as well as what problems migratory birds face.

ACTIVITIES

- 24 European Birdwatching Weekend is organized on 30 September and 1 October 2017
 - 690 participants
 - 20 trips
 - About 100,000 bird species were observed and 139 species recorded
 - The most commonly recorded species: Common Starling, Black-headed Gull and Eurasian Coot.

Evropski vikend posmatranja ptica je događaj koji je prvi put organizovan 1993. godine u Velikoj Britaniji. Tada je organizacija pod imenom International Council for Bird Preservation (Međunarodni savet za očuvanje ptica) sa sedištem u Velikoj Britaniji promenio naziv u BirdLife International, a pomenuti događaj (tada pod nazivom "World Birdwatch") je bio jedna od prvih aktivnosti preimenovane organizacije. Uskoro se događaju pridružuju partneri BirdLife-a iz Evrope, kada svako u svojoj državi organizuje istu aktivnost. Ceo događaj je doživeo veliku popularnost i neverovatan uspeh, zbog čega se narednih godina nastavilo sa organizovanjem iste aktivnosti širom Evrope. Evropski vikend posmatranja ptica sada je već tradicija.

EuroBirdwatch is an event first organized back in 1993 in the UK. A UK-based organization called Council for Bird Preservation changed its name into BirdLife international in the same year, and the event (then called "World Birdwatch") was one of the first activities of the rebranded organization. Soon, BirdLife partners from Europe join the event, when everyone in their own country organizes the same activity. The whole event has enjoyed great popularity and incredible success, which is why it continued to organize the same activity throughout Europe in the coming years. EuroBirdwatch is now a tradition.

U januaru 2017. godine organizovan je 51. popis. Ovaj januar bio je neobično hladan sa 20 ledenih dana sa temperaturama nižim od -20°C i pored teških vremenskih uslova veliki broj volontera se priključio akciji.

- više od 500 km rečnog toka Dunava moralo se obilaziti sa obale, usled leđostaja;
- peške urađen popis na celom toku Zapadne Morave, a obilazeće su i Tisa, Sava, Tamiš, Drina, Nišava i Lim;
- prebrojano preko 287.024 ptica vodenih staništa;
- najbrojnije vrste: lisasta guska (*Anser albifrons*), obični galeb (*Larus ridibundus*) i gluvara (*Anas platyrhynchos*);
- neke od redje beleženih vrsta: ušati gnjurac (*Podiceps auritus*), mali labud (*Cygnus columbianus*), grivasta guska (*Branta bernicla*), belolika guska (*Branta leucopsis*), ledenjarka (*Clangula hyemalis*), baršunasti turpan (*Melanitta fusca*), srednji ronac (*Mergus serrator*), crni orao (*Clanga clanga*) i crni galeb (*Larus marinus*);

- Over 150 birdwatching volunteers;
- 20 field days;
- More than 500 km of Danube river flow had to be made from the coast, due to ice retention;
- A census was made on foot along the entire course of the Zapadna Morava and they were also visited Tisa, Sava, Tamiš, Drina, Nišava and Lim;
- Counted over 287,024 wetland birds;
- The most numerous species: Greater White-fronted Goose (*Anser albifrons*), Black-headed Gull (*Larus ridibundus*) and Mallard (*Anas platyrhynchos*);
- Some of the less frequently recorded species: Horned Grebe (*Podiceps auritus*), Tundra Swan (*Cygnus columbianus*), Brent Goose (*Branta bernicla*), Barnacle Goose (*Branta leucopsis*), Long-tailed Duck (*Clangula hyemalis*), Velvet Scoter (*Melanitta fusca*), Red-breasted Merganser (*Mergus serrator*), Greater Spotted Eagle (*Clanga clanga*) and Great Black-backed Gull (*Larus marinus*);
- A record number of geese has been recorded, the largest since BPSSS coordinates this list.

Međunarodni popis ptica vodenih staništa predstavlja najstariji masovan popis ptica u svetu. Prvi put je organizovan u januaru 1967. godine, a od tada se tokom kratkog zimskog perioda (u januaru) simultano broje ptice na svim vodenim površinama u zapadnoj Evroaziji i Africi.

The International Waterbird Census is the oldest massive bird list in the world. It was first organized in January 1967, and since then, during the short winter period (in January), birds have been simultaneously counted on all water areas in western Eurasia and Africa.

Kroz ovaj program Društvo je želelo da pruži šansu budućim stručnjacima da steknu radno iskustvo u organizaciji koja se bavi zaštitom i proučavanjem ptica i prirode.

- prvu generaciju činilo je troje polaznika: Jelena Babović, Marijana Demajo i Aleksa Vukićević;
- do 1. marta 2018. godine prošli su kroz celokupan sistem rada u Društvu;
- polaznicima programa je pružena prilika da sprovode istraživanja, učestvuju u aktivnoj zaštiti, kreiraju kampanje, sprovode edukativne programe, organizuju javne događaje i učestvuju na naučnim konferencijama;
- pored učešća u aktivnostima Društva polaznici su prošli kroz obuke pisanja projekata i komunikacije sa javnošću.

On 1 November 2017, Bird Protection and Study Society of Serbia began the implementation of a multidisciplinary program of volunteering – “Move for nature”. Through this program, the Society wanted to provide opportunities for future professionals to gain work experience in an organization involved in the protection and study of birds and nature.

- The first generation consisted of three students: Jelena Babović, Marijana Demajo and Aleksa Vukićević;
- By March 1, 2018, they had gone through the entire system of work at the Society;
- The program participants were given the opportunity to conduct research, participate in active nature protection, create campaigns, implement educational programs, organize public events and participate in scientific conferences;
- In addition to participating in the activities of BPSSS, the participants went through training in project writing and public relations.

Tim za borbu protiv krivolova / Serbian Bird Crime Task Force

Tim čine članovi Društva koji zajedno deluju na otkrivanju slučaja krivolova na ptice u Republici Srbiji i bore se da se ova loša praksa, koja izuzetno šteti našoj prirodi, maksimalno suzbije. Aktivnosti Tima sprovode se tokom cele godine, različitim intenzitetom u zavisnosti od potrebe. Tim je osnovan 2014. godine.

Tokom 2017. godine za 60 lovnih dana na prepelicu sprovedeno je 45 terenskih obilazaka.

- zabeleženo 53 slučaja nezakonitog lova na prepelice na 47 lokacija širom Srbije;
- volonteri pronašli ukupno 89 uređaja za vabljene ptice i podneli veliki broj prijava nadležnim organima.

Tim je i ove godine dobio stručnu pomoć od organizacije CABS (Committee Against Bird Slaughter) iz Nemačke, a terenske aktivnosti finansijski je pomogla Švedska kroz program Beogradske otvorene škole „Civilno društvo za unapređenje pristupanja Srbije Evropskoj uniji“.

The team consists of members of the BPSSS who work together to detect the case of bird poaching in the Republic of Serbia and fight to eliminate this bad practice, which is extremely damaging to our nature. Team activities are conducted throughout the year, with varying intensity depending on need. The task force was established in 2014.

During 2017, 45 field trips were conducted for 60 quail hunting days.

- recorded 53 cases of illegal quail hunting at 47 locations throughout Serbia;
- volunteers found a total of 89 illegal calling devices and submitted a large number of reports to the competent authorities.

The team also received expert assistance this year from CABS (Committee Against Bird Slaughter) from Germany, and field activities were financially supported by Sweden through the Belgrade Open School program “Civil Society for Advancing Serbia’s EU Accession”.





Membership map






KONTAKTI SA JAVNOSTI / CONTACTS WITH THE PUBLIC

Značajno vreme u našem radu posvećujemo odgovaranju na pozive i pisanja građana, medija, institucija, udruženja i kompanija. DZPPS pomenutim subjektima pruža potrebne informacije, savete i daje podršku za različite aktivnosti. Ovi kontakti ostvaruju se putem telefonskih poziva na brojeve u našim kancelarijama u Novom Sadu i Beogradu, potom kroz imejl prepisku i u porukama na društvenoj mreži Facebook. U cilju praćenja potreba subjekata koji nam se javljaju, prikupljamo podatke o datumu, lokaciji i razlogu javljanja. Razloge javljanja podelili smo u 22 kategorije. Posebno vredni su nam podaci o nalazima jedinki divljih ptica (žive i mrtve) i slučajevima kršenje zakona.


We dedicate significant time in our work to responding to calls and writings of citizens, media, institutions, CSOs and companies. BPSSS provides the necessary information, advice and support to various entities for various activities. These contacts are made through phone calls to numbers in our offices in Novi Sad and Belgrade, then through email correspondence and in messages on the social network Facebook. In order to monitor the needs of the subjects who contact us, we collect data on the date, location and reason for contacting. We divided the reasons for contacting into 22 categories. The data on wild birds records (living and dead) and illegalities are especially valuable to us.









DZPPS I PTICE U MEDIJIMA / BPSSS AND BIRDS IN THE MEDIA


Najveći broj izazova sa kojima se susrećemo u zaštiti ptica i prirode proistekli su iz loše informisanosti i manjka znanja određenih društvenih grupa. Jedan od strateški važnih ciljeva našeg rada jeste povećanje znanja šire javnosti o potrebi za istraživanjem i zaštitom ptica i prirode. U formiranju javnog mnjenja posebno važnu ulogu imaju masovni mediji. Da bismo izmerili naš uticaj na kreiranje javnog mnjenja kroz medijske priloge u štampanim, TV, radio i internet medijima, sprovedeno je istraživanje uglavnom kroz plaćenu uslugu press clippinga, manjim delom kroz sopstvenu pretragu medijskih sadržaja. Ključni pojmovi koji su praćeni u medijskim objavama su: 1) Dušto za zaštitu i proučavanje ptica Srbije; 2) divlje ptice; 3) krivolov.




Positive reports - present good news; **Negative reports** - present bad news; **Negative reports about birds** - articles present the negative attitudes of the public towards birds.

Most of the challenges we face in the areas of bird and nature conservation originate from poor information and lack of knowledge of certain social groups. One of the strategically important goals of our work is to increase the knowledge of the general public about the need for research and conservation of birds and nature. The mass media have a particularly important role in shaping public opinion. In order to measure our influence on the creation of public opinion through media reports in printed, TV, radio and internet media, the research was conducted mainly through a paid press clipping service, to a lesser extent through our own search of media content. The key terms that are followed in media publications are: 1) Birds Protection and Study Society of Serbia; 2) wild birds; 3) poaching.
